The Company

"Liberi Di... Physical Theatre" was founded in Milan, in 2007 by Davide Agostini, Stefano Pribaz, Valentina Marino and Giulia Piolanti. The four artists have in common a background of very high level in both artistic and rhythmic gymnastics, years of experience on international stages a great passion. The creative path starts under the magic big top at the "Piccola Scuola di Circo" (circus school) in Milan, in 2008. During the following years the company keeps growing, with the arrival of new artists coming from different backgrounds, ranging from theatre to dance to circus. Combining different disciplines and styles has molded a new physical language, that allows Liberi Di to range from breathtaking acrobatics, to emotional aesthetic performance, to hilarious non-verbal comedy.

In 2013 Liberi Di inaugurates its new headquarters in Milan, where the new adventure "Liberi Di School" is started. In summer 2015 the company is split between Expo Milano 2015, and the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, and in 2017 the company lands overseas for the first time, at the New Victory Theatre in New York City.


Today Liberi Di is a firm-based reality for live shows in Italy and Europe, with a prestigious curriculum and many important collaborations including Balich World Shows, La Fura Dels Baus and Cirque Du Soleil among others.



The school

The school was started in 2013, as the result of our desire to spread our passion through teaching the several disciplines that form our language. The school is located in the beautiful context of Milan ancient industrial area, in a space that has become the new meeting point for performing arts in the city.

Thanks to the experience acquired during many years on stage the company shares with its students techniques and ways to achieve the highest level at acrobatics, aerial dance, contortion, and physical theatre. Anybody is welcome, children or adults, beginners and professionals, all the students are encouraged to let their talent shine.





The founders



Davide "Ago" Agostini was born near Venice in 1976. Until 2000 he is a gymnast in the highest national league, and in 2001 he graduates in sport science at Padova University. After his gymnastics career he studies dance and drama and becomes an

artist for the company "Kataklò", that allows him to perform worldwide until 2007. In the same year he is cofounder of the company "Liberi Di... Physical Theatre", of which he still is the president and artistic director.



Stefano Pribaz was born in Trieste in in 1974. He was a gymnast in the highest national league, famous for the natural grace of his movements. His career in gymnastics comes to an end in 2000, same year in which he graduates in computer

engineering. His new life as a performer starts in 2003, when he becomes an artist for the company "Kataklò", in 2007 he is one of the cofounders of Liberi Di.

He is currently the company technical manager.



Valentina Marino was born in Siracusa in 1977. Her extraordinary rhythmic gymnastics career brings her to participate to 5 World Championships and culminates in the Olympic Games in 1996 in Atlanta. After gymnastics she graduates in sport science

and becomes an artist in the company "Kataklò" in 2000. In 2007 she is cofounder of the company Liberi Di. She is currently a company artist and choreographer, a rhythmic gymnastics coach and an aerial dance teacher.

Acrobat, dancer, aerialist and contortionist, Francesca was born in Massa (Italy) in 1984. After her career in rhythmic gymnastics at national level, she obtains a RAD diploma, intermediate level, issued by the London





Dancer, acrobat, hand balancer and aerialist, Antonio was born in Lecce (Italy) in 1991. His dance career started with breaking, but was later enriched by many other dance styles, ranging from hip hop to modern

contemporary. He is a well experienced performer with an international prestigious resume, when he joins Liberi Di in 2015.



Eleni Ouartana

Dancer, aerialist and contortionist, Eleni was born in Mazara del Vallo (Italy) in 1994. Her dance education starts with ballet, and goes on with modern contemporary and acrobatic dance. She obtains her profes-

sional dancer diploma at MAS (Music, Arts and Show) Academy in Milan in 2016, and she joins Liberi Di in the same year. She is also a dance and aerial teacher.



General tecnichal requirements

The following rider is a guide and can be adjusted as necessary, please see the specific show for details

Stage (Ideal stage dimensions)

- From 10m x 8m to 12mx10m- 3 legs each side
- minimum grid height: 6.5m
- black backdrop
- Spectraculum requires a white pvc screen because of the digital projections.
- Fog Machine
- Stage floor must be smooth and covered in black dance floor

Sound Equipment

- we will provide a laptop with prerecorded soundtrack
- a public address system capable of projecting quality sound equally to all seats in the auditorium
- separately controlled on-stage monitor system
- communication headset system with minimum of three stations
- all other components necessary to constitute a complete, working system.
- * Sound system must be placed, patched and in working order prior to arrival of company

Dressing Rooms

 Separate dressing rooms capable of accommodating a minimum of 5 men and 5 women located no more than one floor from stage level equipped with make-up tables, mirrors, chairs, adequate lighting, costume racks, nearby restrooms independent of public lavatories, and showers.

Wardrobe

- Washer and dryer for exclusive use of company from arrival to end of load out
- Iron and ironing board
- Wardrobe racks in each dressing room
- Additional storage area for technical equipment and props
- Two parking spaces and any required permits in close proximity to theatre.


Convention and events


